Please refer to Case SS-208-C considered in conference May 31, 1949 relative to claim of Conductor R. V. Smith, LaCrosse Division, for payment of the mileage of a road trip on waycar 13839 between North LaCrosse and Dayton's Bluff, September 12, 1948, because of not being called after laying off sick until he had obtained release from the Doctor.

We feel quite sure that the requirement imposed in this case was the outgrowth of instructions issued during the war period to prevent anything but bona fide lay-offs account illness. Those instructions, of course, were not issued for the purpose of applying to one individual and not to another, as you expressed the situation to have been in another case on this docket. We will, however, restore the practice which was in effect prior to the above-mentioned instructions and require no certificate from the Doctor unless the illness runs over 6 days. The claim in this particular case will be allowed.
